



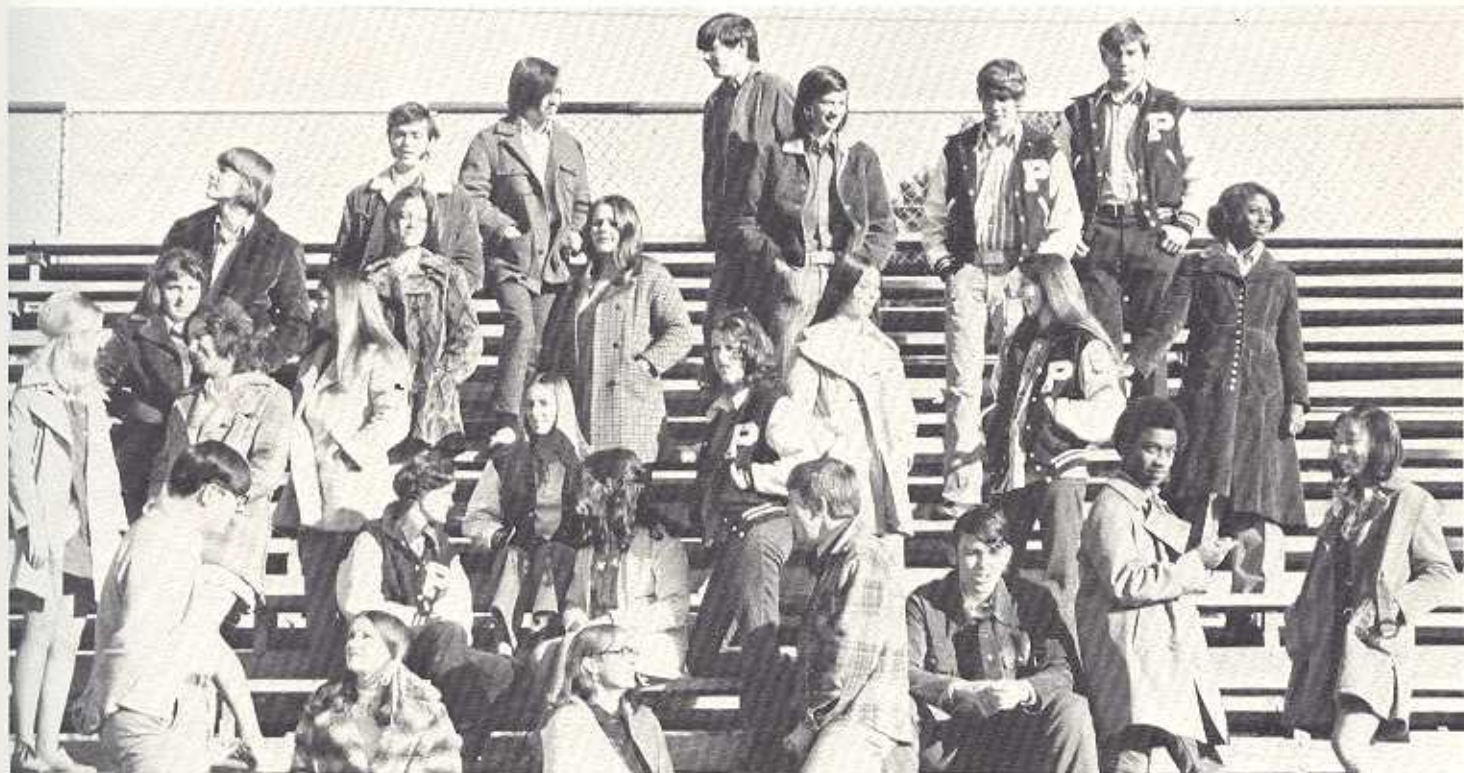
Angela Payne learned of the many extra duties associated with being president of the National Honor Society.
