



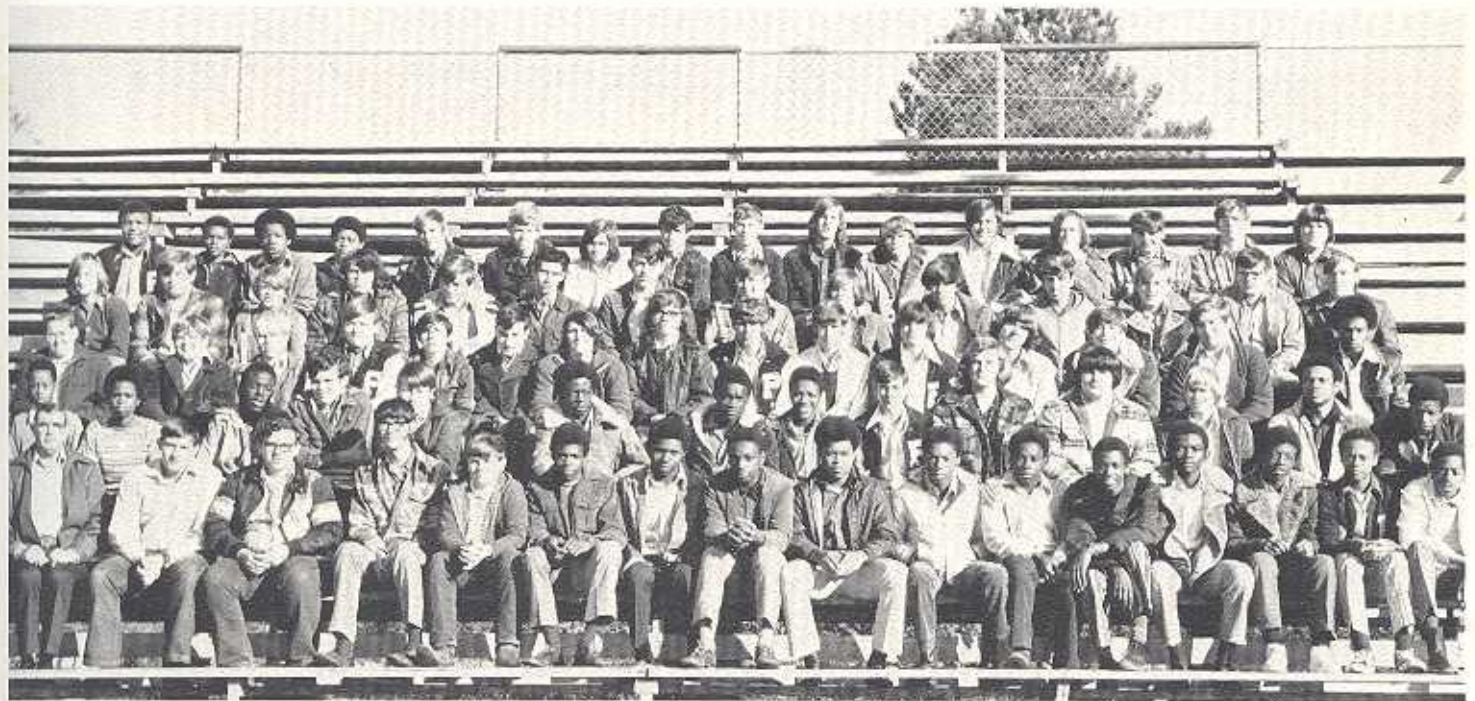
Sammy Westmorland discussed the charter and purposes of FFA to the new members.
