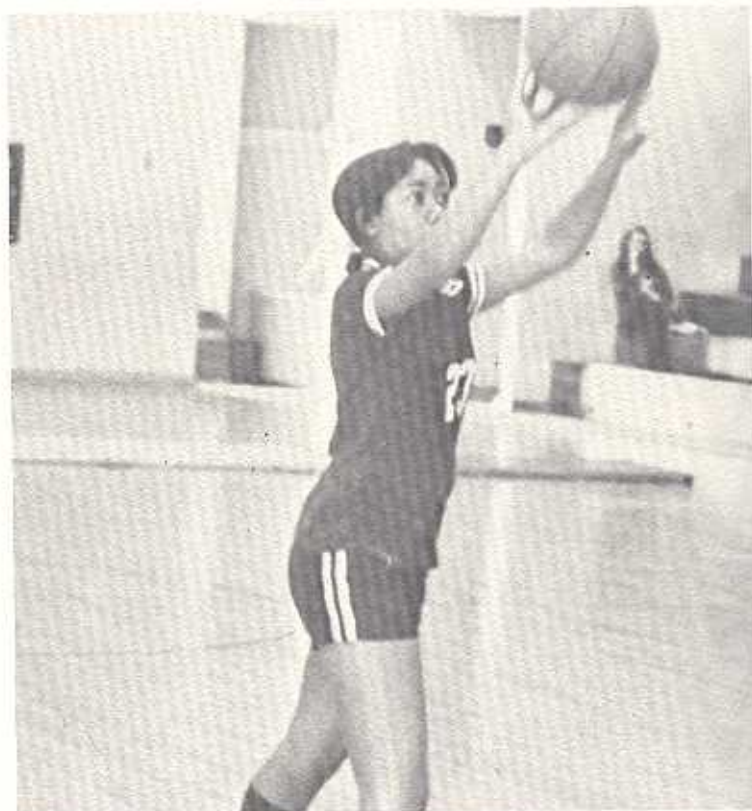
The junior girls went into every game with the determination needed to win. They played with teamwork and sportsmanship, which are perhaps the two more important qualities in a good basketball team.
